We will be more effective as working towards long term change if we work towards dealing with the underlying issues than fire-fighting each behaviour. 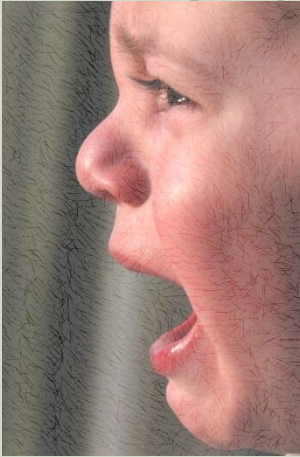
